Joshua 21.43-44: already but not yet, like our Christian life! Joshua 22.1-9: Commendation and commissioning of the Eastern tribes Lessons to be learnt in Joshua 22.10-34:

1. Conflicts are inevitable	
2. "Carefrontation" is important	
3. Common allegiance is imperative	
0	Peor (cf. Numbers 25.1-8) & Achan (cf. Joshua 7)

0	Zeal for the Lord's name and purity of allegiance
