Introduction

Background

- Focuses on 3 main religious practices of the time: a) Giving, b) Prayer, c) Fasting.
- Recall Matt 5:20: The righteousness of Christ's followers must surpass that of the Pharisees and teachers of the law.
- Jesus highlights the (non)-examples of the Pharisees and teachers of the law and instructs what the right kind of righteousness looks like.

What does the Right Kind of Righteousness look like?

- 1. Not self-seeking but God-pleasing (v2-6)
- 2. Not mindless legalism but should lead to spiritual transformation (v7-15)
- 3. Not about external appearances but the inner attitude (v16-18)

Implications for us

- 1. Surrender our pride
- 2. Guard the best of our intentions
- 3. Entrust our need for affirmation

Reflection

- 1. Have we been faithful in the practice of our spiritual disciplines?
- 2. Which areas do we need God to deal with us (i.e. surrender, guarding, entrusting)?
