3 Observations:

- 1. The Beatitudes are an interconnected whole.
- 2. "Blessed" doesn't refer to what we think but what God thinks of our situation.
- 3. The Beatitudes cannot be separated from the Gospel.

The Beatitudes (Matthew 5:3-12)

- 1. Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.
- 2. Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted.
- 3. Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth.
- 4. Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.
- 5. Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy.
- 6. Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.
- 7. Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God.
- 8. Blessed are those who are persecuted because of righteousness, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Salty and Shining (Matthew 5:13-16)

If the world is not changed, we need to take a good look at ourselves and ask, "what has happened to our saltiness? What has happened to our brightness?"
